### Illinois Paint Horse Association Scholarship Program

#### Purpose:

To provide scholarship funds for IPHA members pursuing a college education.

### Who Qualifies?

Any IPHA member in good standing who is actively involved in the club or youth activities. This fund is dedicated, but not limited, to college-age students between the ages of 18-24 years.

### Amount of Scholarship Awards:

The dollar amount and number of scholarships awarded shall be decided by a vote of the membership at the January General Membership meeting based on the financial report from the preceding year. Funds will be paid directly to the educational institution, and shall ONLY be used for tuition and/or books.

#### Scholarship Selection:

The IPHA Board of Directors will review all eligible applications and award the scholarship(s). The decision of the IPHA Board of Directors shall be final.

#### How to Apply:

Applicants must submit the official application form to the IPHA Treasurer. Applications will be accepted until August 1 of each year. The scholarship award is applicable for one year, and students are eligible to reapply and receive funding in successive years.

- Scholarships will be awarded upon proof of registration at an accredited community college, junior college, college or university.
